It was moved by Stock and seconded by Hecht to amend the agenda to consider transfers to Secondary Roads. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to approve the agenda as amended. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Hecht to approve a proposed tile repair in Drainage District 67 located in Section 26, Eden Township in the amount of \$300.00. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to approve a proposed tile repair in Joint Drainage District 64 & 105 located in Section 1, Delaware Township in the amount of \$5,100.00. Ayes all, motion carried.

The County Engineer updated the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to approve a Policy for Traffic Signage Repair and Replacement for Secondary Road signs. Ayes all, motion carried.
