The Sac County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with all members present, Rick Hecht, Chairman, presiding. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as submitted.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Drake to approve the agenda as posted. Ayes all, motion carried.

Kari Musselman, Sac County Support Services Case Manager, advised the Board of the resignation of Andrea Taylor, case manager. No action was taken.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Drake to approve the claims as listed on the claims register in the Auditor's office. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Drake to adopt a resolution relocating the County's ATV/UTV ordinance to chapter ten of Title IV of the Sac County Code of Ordinances. Ayes Drake, Hecht and Stock; nays none, motion carried.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Stock to adopt a resolution expanding the prohibition of the use of engine and compression brakes ("Jake Brakes") to all public highways in Sac County that are within one mile of any incorporated municipality in Sac County. Ayes Drake, Hecht and Stock, nays none, motion carried.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Drake to amend the County's ATV/UTV ordinance to allow the use of ATV's or UTV's in Sac County which are properly registered in another county or municipality. Ayes Drake, Hecht and Stock, nays none, motion carried.

The County Engineer updated the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Stock to approve the final DOT audit for the County Road D-59 overlay project. Ayes all, motion carried.

With there being no further business, on motion, the meeting was adjourned.
