The Sac County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with all members present, Jim Wissler, Chairman, presiding. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as submitted.

It was moved by Wilhelm and seconded by Drake to amend the agenda to consider renewal of a substance abuse prevention contract. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Wilhelm and seconded by Drake to approve the agenda as amended. Ayes all, motion carried.

Representatives from the Black Hawk Lake Preservation Association, the City of Lake View and the Iowa DNR were present to update the Board on lake improvement projects and to request funding for the next year.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Wilhelm to commit \$3,900 to the Black Hawk Lake improvement projects for 20/21. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Wilhelm and seconded by Drake to approve a shared contract with Calhoun County for the County Engineer position which had been vacated by the resignation of Zac Anderson. Ayes all, motion carried. The Calhoun County Board of Supervisors offered the position to Nick Buse of Lake View.

The Board discussed the recommendations of the Sac County Compensation Board and wages of all county employees. The Board directed the County Auditor to adjust the proposed budgets to reflect the following increases: all county support staff including Secondary Roads employees – 2.5%, all County Conservation staff – 5%, naturalist – 8%, Veteran’s Affairs Director – 4%, Auditor, Attorney and Sheriff – 1.05%, Recorder and Treasurer – 3.63% and Supervisors – 0. The Board will review the entire budget at a later date.

Dawn Mentzer updated the Board on Rolling Hills Community Services and a funding request of \$312,424.00 for fiscal year ending June 30,2021.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Wilhelm to approve the claims as listed on the claims register in the Auditor’s office. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Wilhelm and seconded by Drake to approve the Condemnation Commission for Sac County for 2020. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Wilhelm to approve the drainage claims as submitted. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Wilhelm to approve the renewal of the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment grant between Sac County and the State of Iowa for 2020. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Wilhelm and seconded by Drake to approve a claim in the amount of \$1,457.47 submitted by Buena Vista County Secondary Roads for repairs to Joint DD 41-43 located in Section 33, Providence Township, Buena Vista County. Ayes all, motion carried.

With there being no further business, on motion, the meeting was adjourned.
