The Sac County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with all members present, Rick Hecht, Chairman, presiding. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as submitted.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Drake to approve the agenda as posted. Ayes all, motion carried.

There was no citizen input for this meeting.

At 10:30, as advertised, the Chairman opened the public hearing to consider an ordinance regulating outdoor advertising, signs and billboards. Sherrie Wilson, Sac County Zoning Officer was present to join the discussion about the proposed ordinance and fees for permits.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Stock to close the public hearing. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Stock to waive the second and third readings of the proposed ordinance and adopt the ordinance as proposed with a permit fee schedule as follows: signs up to twenty-five square feet - \$25.00, signs of twenty six to ninety-nine square feet - \$50.00 and signs of 100 square feet and above - \$100. A \$100 late fee can be assessed if construction is started prior to application for the permit. Ayes Drake, Hecht and Stock; nays none, motion carried.

The County Engineer updated the board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Stock to approve application for an 8" tile crossing between Sections 31 and 32, Clinton Twp. Ayes all, motion carried.

With there being no further business, on motion, the meeting was adjourned.
